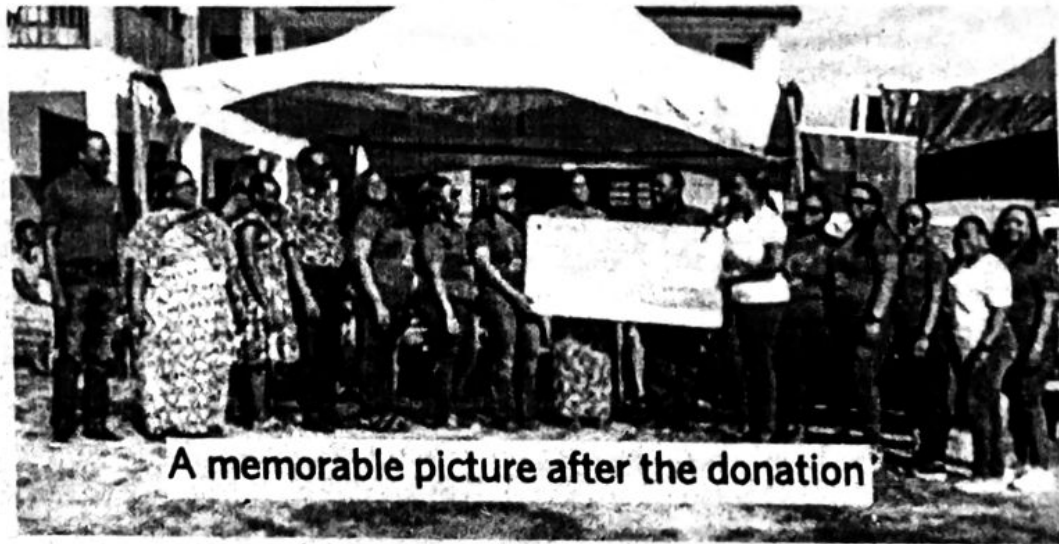


Stanbic Women Donate To Serwaa Nyarko Girls SHS
