These women will share insights and experiences, inspiring others to break barriers and excel in their respective fields.

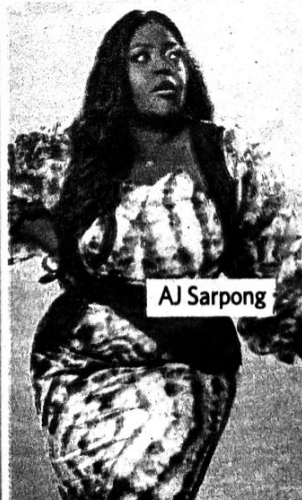
Under Claudia's leadership, the summit has addressed the unique challenges faced by female CEOs, providing a platform for networking, mentorship, and knowledge exchange.
