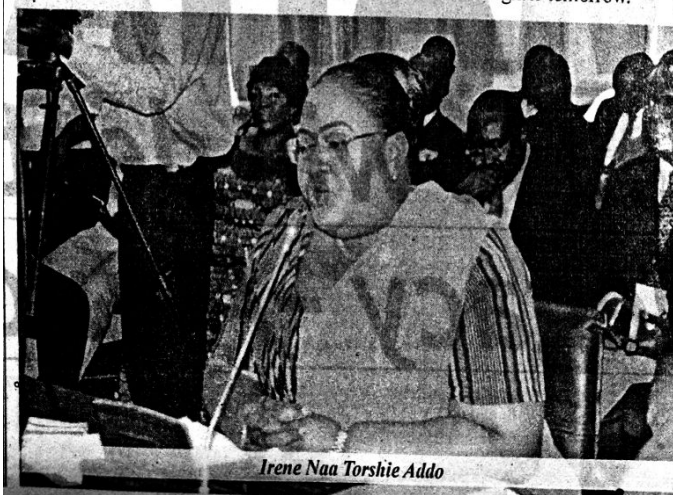
Vice-Presidential candidacy would be a significant milestone in our party's history and a powerful affirmation of the pivotal role women have played in shaping our success thus far."
